



2nd Annual CVGA Open Division Tour Championship & Final Foursome

The Tour Championship and Final Foursome is a season ending event that features an 80-player field and an enhanced purse. This unique playing opportunity is designed to motivate CVGA Players to earn a top place in the season long point standings. This event will allow the season long points and players of the year to be finalized before the college players return to fall competition.

Field Size:

Open to all CVGA Open Division Players: Limited to 80 Players

Format:

Phase 1 – 18 Hole Stroke Play – **The CVGA Tour Championship**

All Players will participate in 18 holes of stroke play. There will be a normal skins game and regular event payout. The player who shoots the lowest 18-hole score will be the Tour Champion, and receive credit for a normal CVGA Tour Win. The Tour Championship will be based on the 24 Point payout system.

The player of the year points will be finalized and awarded for all categories, and the season long awards will be awarded based on the finishing order following phase 1.

The 80 players who qualify for the tournament will be assigned to one of four groups before the tournament begins, seeded by their position in the points standing through the Turtleback Open. The top 30 will be seeded into three groups of ten players each. (The first 30) The remaining 50 players will be placed into the fourth group of qualifiers. (The next 50)

Phase 2 – The Final Foursome

- The 4 players that shoot the lowest 18-hole score *from each* of the 4 groups will move on to compete in the Final Foursome. 1 player will qualify from each of Group A,B,C, and D. In the event of a tie for the lowest score in any given group, the players with the highest seed will represent the perspective group.
- The final four player scores will reset. They will play extra holes of stroke play* for the title “Final Foursome Champion”. They will also win the sponsor based final foursome payout.
- The final Foursome payout is separate from the Tour Championship payout. It will be paid out in cash to all participants in the final foursome.

1st Place – \$1,000.00

2nd Place – \$500.00

3rd Place – \$300.00

4th Place – \$200.00

**It may be 9 holes of stroke play, or in the event of time constraints due to weather, darkness, course conditions etc. the final foursome may be played as a combination of an aggregate playoff, shootout, or sudden death playoff format.*
