Congratulations to Brian Hills for capturing his first CVGA Open title at the 2025 Turtleback Open. His solid round of 4 under par 67, featured 3 birdies, a hole out for eagle, and a lone bogey. The golf professional from Buffalo, MN is one of the many Second Swing associated golfers that play in the CVGA.



Nearly missing out on back-to-back wins, and finishing solo second, was CVGA Champion Tyler DeBruyckere with a 3 under par 68. The former CSP Bear is headed out to Colorado to compete at Denver Christian School next season.

UW-Stout Blue Devil Andrew Bauer turned in another fine performance with 70, finishing tied for third. Near the top of the points for a second straight season, Andrew is in the hunt to "one up" his runner up player of the year finish in 2024. Another points leader, Josh Malnory, was also tied for third with a 70. He positioned himself well for next week with another great round.

Rounding out the top ten with even par 71's were professionals Eric Anderson and Taylor Koser, with amateur Jeff Galowitz, who is playing well going into the Tour Championship at his home course next Saturday!

Sawyer Bailey, Stellan Orvick, and Tony Grabowske shot 1 over par 72's to finish in a 3-way tie for 8th place.

The entire skin pot was won by our champion, Brian Hills with a birdie on 6, and a hole out eagle on number 11. What a day for Brian!

Will Schlitz narrowly held on to his Player of the Year lead by a single point over Andrew Bauer. Nipping at their heels are Stellan Orvick, Josh Malnory, and Tyler DeBruyckere, as we head to Stillwater Country Club to settle things next week. Matt Kamish is leading the Senior award, and Bryce Killoren is ahead for the High School award. They both have challenges that could sneak up on them. With the 24-point system in play for the Tour Championship, a wild finish is on the horizon for the season long player of the year races.

We started out with a little fog, but the course and weather were both awesome. Special thanks to Bruce, Kevin and the staff at Turtleback for putting on another great event. The course and clubhouse are looking great with all the changes they have been making!
